

Can you believe it? April 1st marked one year of service with you, for Him. I was caught off guard by this until I happened to realize Easter's sunrise service and breakfast was my last "first." How'd this happen?! I'll tell you how it happened: God and His people. If you don't know how I got here, there's more to it than the typical apply for job > interview for job > find out if job is offered or not > proceed accordingly. There's an entire story written by hand of God which landed you and I at this

place together, and I am grateful for His

authorship over it all.



When I left youth ministry nearly 10 years ago, it was for no other reason than to follow the direction of God. I had great peace giving up something I loved in order to grow in ways I didn't know needed growing and to blindly walk where my Savior was leading.

Where were you, First Inwood, 10 years ago? I wasn't here to know, but I do know these things: both you and I didn't even imagine this is how things would look now, in May 2019. You didn't know you'd have a youth director on staff and you certainly didn't know you'd have this space (a designated youth room). And if you did have an inkling about the space, you probably didn't know it'd be filled to the gills 3-4 times per month with 35-40 youth. And you might not have known then that these youth would show up around 7pm and some not leave until 9:30 p.m. because they've got this space... and it's safe... and it's His. And what's more – they bring friends. Did you know this is what it would look like 10 years ago?? Would you have imagined all this?

And I.... I didn't know I would reenter youth ministry. I didn't know I would be ever so blessed in this field as I have been in the last 12 months that my soul would be consumed with fire for the teens of our communities. I didn't know I'd have co-workers who pour themselves into their careers as pastor, secretary, and custodian to the degree that I feel like I have encountered Jesus when we collaborate for the good of The Church. I didn't know I'd serve alongside volunteers who enthusiastically give more time and energy in education and other ministry areas than I've ever noted in a local body of Christ. I never could have imagined all this.

Y'all, do not lose heart if you cannot imagine how life is going to work out in another, say, 10 years. Do not let what used to be get in the way of what is to come. Do not let your comfort zone cripple what God is authoring in His Church. Do not let your finite sight keep you from walking by faith into His plans. Do not let your fear or the challenges of change prevent you from walking where your Savior is leading.

Thank you for the last 12 months. God is at work here. Be so moved by His faithfulness, His authorship, His Word that you can set aside the things you can't imagine for the hope He has promised! To God be the glory both now and forever more!
