- Jake has been healing up very well from his surgery. He has a 3-inch incision on his left side where the mass was taken out. When they removed the mass, they also took part of his kidney surrounding the mass. Pathology examined the mass and confirmed last week Friday that the mass removed was Wilm's Tumor, which is what he was diagnosed with in May of 2018. He had a CT scan done of his lungs this past Tuesday morning to check that the cancer did not spread there. It came back clear! They are hopeful that the cancer was contained to the mass that was removed from his kidney. They had a consultation with Jake's oncology team this past Thursday to weigh their options of treatment for Jake. They are also seeking a second opinion of treatment from Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. They are being referred by Jake's oncologist to the Mayo Clinic in hopes of scheduling a consultation with them soon so Jake can get the best care and best options for him. Mark and Carrie would like to thank everybody for their kind words and prayers. We are very blessed that God has cured Jake once before and we are hopeful that He will have healing hands upon Jake to cure him again.
