



's 2023 BITES & BIDS SUPPER & AUCTION!

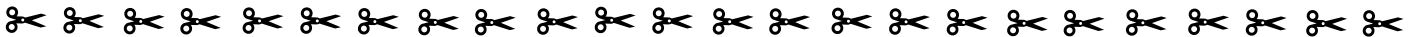
Impact is excited to offer a fun, church-wide event on **Wednesday, November 1!** We will be hosting a Basket Battle - Bake Sale – Supper & Auction! Our goal is to raise \$9,150 with this event (that’s \$1,002 more than last year) – will you help us surpass that??!

BASKET BATTLE & BAKE SALE: A friendly competition for *all* ages! One person challenges another person to creating, providing, or baking a specific item. Both people bring their final product to the church on November 1. Your items should be labeled with what they are (i.e. 3 dozen chocolate chip cookies; car cleaning basket; local gift card, Christmas decoration, movie basket, MN Vikings basket, etc.). Your basket or item(s) will be “checked-in” to one of two categories: Bake Sale or Auction. **Note:** The Bake Sale will be run as a free-will donation sale.

Anyone can challenge *anyone* to a battle! Get creative and have some fun! Variety will make this event really great (see reverse for ideas)! Extra battle slips are located by the church mailboxes – challenge more than one person to a battle!

BITES (SUPPER): We will serve a free-will donation supper from 6 to 7 p.m. Anyone is welcome to enjoy taverns, hot dogs, coney dogs, salads, and chips. The Auction will follow.

BIDS (AUCTION): After you’ve browsed the goods and enjoyed your meal, stay for a wild auction of the items! This is the perfect opportunity to do some early Christmas shopping! Get those arms ready (to raise your bids and carry your winnings home)! Begins at 7:15 p.m.
